Code of Conduct

The college has formulated its own code of conduct (i.e. a set of rules and regulations) which governs the behavior or conduct of individuals entering the college premises in the capacity of any one of the following:

- 1) Staff members
- 2) Students

Code of Conduct for Staff members:

Ours is a government run college where all the teaching, non-teaching administrating staff is appointed by Government of Gujarat. Hence, all the staff is abide by the Gujarat Public Service Rules (GCSR) and amendments made therein time to time by the government. Here the detailed GCSR be accessed ([Link to GCSR](#)).

Code of Conduct for students:

The college has well described code of conduct for students as follows

1. All the students have to follow this code of conduct strictly, failing to this may impose actions and punishment accordingly.
2. Outsiders and non students are not allowed to enter the college campus without prior permission.
3. All the students shall wear Identity Card at all the time while on the campus.
4. No students are allowed to seat outside of classrooms and laboratories in spare time.
5. Students are supposed to leave the college campus after the completion of college hours.
6. In spare time and inbetween lectures and practicals, use library, girl's room or chemistry ground for reading, don't wander in nearby college passage (art's collage), parking area and outside of the college campus.

7. Use of electronic gadgets like mobiles, tablets, laptops etc. is strictly prohibited during classroom teaching and practicals. Students can use electronic gadgets only in notified areas on campus.
8. Students have to follow the rules of the presence, submission of journals/assignments/projects, grant of terms as per the norms laid down by the college and university.
9. Students are not supposed to invite friends and relatives in the college campus, in case of misconduct, disciplinary actions will be taken immediately.
10. Consumption of intoxicants, smoking, chewing tobacco and/or use of pan-masala, gutka etc. is strictly prohibited and punishable as per government rules.
11. Keep the campus neat and clean. Don't put waste anywhere in the campus except dustbins and garbage bins.
12. At the time of prayer/assembly, maintain self discipline and decorum.
13. Vehicles must be parked in the parking lot.
14. Carefully handle furniture, equipments, appliances of the college and labs. In any case of damage to college property, the responsible students have to bear the cost of replacement/repair with fine.
15. No unnecessary gathering in college campus is allowed.
16. The college campus including classrooms, laboratories, offices etc. are under CCTV camera surveillance for the safety and security of students and properties. In case of any instance of non compliance of existing rules, disciplinary procedure will be followed.
17. There are certain committees and staff members including HoDs and Principal for maintenance of discipline, prevention of ragging and sexual harassment, student grievances redressal and for decorum and discipline. So student has to bear with utmost discipline and decorum.

Violation of college policies in any case will be considered serious offence and actions will be taken accordingly.
